The Articles Training Program (ATP) is operated by the Legal Practice Board for the purpose of training and assessment of articled clerks in Skills, Practice Areas and Values prescribed in the Board Rules relating to admission. The ATP is deemed a QA Provider for the purpose of the Board's CPD requirements. Accordingly, Legal Practitioners who participate as a teacher or presenter in any of the courses operated by the ATP will be eligible to qualify for CPD points in respect of that participation as set out in the table below:
