

DISCIPLINARY HEARING
REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS

On 17 October 2003 the Legal Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal resolved to submit a Report to the Full Court of the Supreme Court of Western Australia recommending that Mr Andrew Roderick Fraser be struck off the Roll of Practitioners in this State because of his illegal conduct.

The evidence before the Tribunal was that the practitioner's name had previously been removed from the Roll of Practitioners for Victoria. The practitioner had been found guilty in the County Court of Victoria of being knowingly concerned in the importation of not less than a commercial quantity of cocaine; of trafficking in that drug and having in his possession a quantity of ecstasy. On 3 December 2001 he was sentenced by the County Court of Victoria to a term of imprisonment of 6 years with a minimum of 4 years. This evidence was accepted by the Tribunal which decided he was unfit to practice in this State. The above mentioned Report to the Full Court of the Supreme Court was then ordered.
